



Fall 2016 Partisan Primary

The Partisan Primary will be held Tuesday, August 9, 2016. Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. The Partisan Primary is a nominating process. Voting in this primary is your opportunity to express to one party of your choice, which of the party's candidates you recommend for placement on the General Election Ballot. Republican Offices on the ballot are U.S. Senator, Representative in Congress, District 7, Legislative and State District Attorney and District 73 Representative to the Assembly are write in votes. Locally on the Republican ballot will be County Clerk, Lolita Olson, County Treasurer, Nicole Tims, and Register of Deeds, Renee M. Bell. Partisan Office/Democratic Party for U.S. Senator, Representative in Congress, District 7, Representative to the Assembly District 73, and District Attorney. Locally, County Clerk, County Treasurer and Register of Deeds are write in votes. Partisan Office Constitution Party, Libertarian Party and the Wisconsin Green Party are all write in votes for U.S. Senator, Representative in Congress District 7, Representative to the Assembly District 73, District Attorney and locally County Clerk, County Treasurer, and Register of Deeds.

Fall 2016 General Election

This General Election will be held **Tuesday**, **November 8**, **2016** for President, U.S. Senator, U.S. Representative, evennumbered Wisconsin State Senate seats, all Wisconsin Assembly seats, and all District Attorneys.

Election Registration

Recent changes in the voter ID requirements are now here. You are required to show your Photo ID at your polling place for all elections. Please make sure your photo ID matches the address you registered to vote with. If not please make sure you have supporting documentation such as a utility bill with your name and address showing that you are still eligible to vote in the Village of Minong. When you are going to vote, please have your Photo ID with you, or you will not be able to cast your ballot that day. Due to a high voter turnout expected, if you are not registered to vote yet for the Village of Minong, please come in to our office prior to the Fall or General Elections and register to vote with your photo ID to ensure you are included on the election day poll list. To see a list of acceptable forms of ID's stop in to the Village of Minong Office from 7:30 am to 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday. You can register online at

myvote.wi.gov, but you will still need to bring in your WI photo ID to vote on election day.
