COMING SOON: PAY YOUR WATER/SEWER BILL BY DEBIT OR CREDIT CARD AT THE MINONG VILLAGE OFFICE

The Minong Village office is happy to announce that we will soon be accepting utility payments for water/sewer via your debit or credit card through GovPay.net. Payments will have to be made here at the village office to start, but eventually, a link will be provided on our website to pay your bill from home at your convenience. There will be card processing fees for using your debit or credit card to process your payment. You can find those rates below or you can always call the Minong Village Office for more information. As always we will still be accepting payments in form of cash, money order or check. We hope to start processing payments via debit or credit by August, 2018.

UPCOMING PARTISAN PRIMARY AUGUST 14TH, 2018

Another election is coming up! So, what is the Partisan Primary? Why are there so many ballots? Why can I only choose one ballot?

It's all about the "Parties" in a Partisan Primary. Voters select a candidate to be a political party's nominee for a given office in advance of an upcoming general election.

In order to narrow the field of candidates for an upcoming general election you must choose a party ballot, whether that would be Republican, Democrat, the Constitution Party, the Libertarian Party or the Green Party. You are choosing candidates based on the party ballot, If you vote for different candidates on more than one ballot your vote will not be counted. So, take your time, read the ballot instructions carefully before choosing your party ballot.

Please remember to make sure you are registered to vote. You can check that information online by going to: www.myvote.wi.gov, on the main page and click on "My Voter Info". If you are not registered click on "Register to Vote" on the main page to register.

As always, a current government issued ID is required to vote in all elections. That includes a Wisconsin Drivers License or Identification card, unexpired military ID, Tribal ID card, or certificate of Naturalization. You can find out more at: www.bringit.wi.gov.

Filling your Pool This Summer?

Please be advised that the Village of Minong will no longer allow residents to call in with their pool fill information.

We will be enforcing our ordinance under section 26-60 Bulk Water: All *bulk water* supplied to fill tank trucks or swimming pools from the *water* system through hydrants or other connections shall be metered. We will require residents to pay a \$40 refundable deposit to pick up a meter before the pool is filled and return the meter once finished so that we can get a more accurate water reading. SUMMER JETTING TO KEEP WATER/SEWER LINES CLEAR

The Village of Minong is planning a summer jetting project in certain areas of the village. Please make sure you keep your toilet lids down in your home this summer and be on the lookout for a “big white truck”.



Cross-Connection Surveys

The Village will be conducting residential cross-connection surveys as required by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. These surveys are essential to insure there are no connections between the potable water supply and any source of possible contamination.

UPCOMING LOCAL ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FOR THE VILLAGE OF MINONG

The Village of Minong will begin a road improvement project that includes repaving and shouldering of approximately 634 lineal feet of existing pavement on Main Street from 8th Ave to a point approximately 634 feet north of 8th Ave including portions of the intersection of Main Street and 7th Ave.

This project is funded in part by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation Local Roads Improvement Fund and will begin approximately around late summer.
