REMINDER—DOG LICENSES DUE BY APRIL 1ST, 2019

Pursuant to WI Stat/ 174-052, notice is hereby given to all Washburn County dog owners that you are required to license and vaccinate for rabies under the provisions of WI State. 95.21(2), any dog over 5 months of age. The license year is from Jan 1—Dec 31. Dogs not licensed within 30 days of ownership or after 5 months of age will be subject to a late fee of not less than \$5 per dog and will be subject to citation and forfeiture.

- Neutered Male-\$5.00
- Spayed Female-\$5.00
- Male-\$10.00
- Female-\$10.00
- Kennel-\$50.00 (Three dogs or more in a single household)

ROAD BAN INFORMATION FOR OUR AREA

Road Bans will go on March 20, 2019 at 12:01 pm (noon). Notice will be posted on the Washburn County Highway Department website at www.co.washburn.wi.us. Or by calling the Highway Department at 715-635-4480.

The following Washburn County roads are posted at:

6 ton max. For any single axle

10 ton max. For any two axles under 8 feet apart

- CTH "BB" from CTH B to Sawyer County Line
- CTH "E" from STH "63" south & west to CTH "M"
- CTH "F" from STH "63" west to the North Road
 - "F" from STH "53" west to CTH "K"
 - "F" (loop)-from CTH "K" to STH "77"
- CTH "G" from STH "77" north to Douglas County Line
- CTH "I" from STH "77" to the end
- CTH "M" from STH "70" north to STH "63"
 - "M" from Stanberry Road north to STH "77"
- CTH "P" from CTH "B" to CTH "D"

This list above is subject to change pending conditions. The following road(s) in the Village are subject to the ban.

Filling your Pool This Summer?

Please be advised that the Village of Minong will no longer allow residents to call in with their pool fill information.



We will be enforcing our ordinance under section 26-60 Bulk Water: All *bulk water* supplied to fill tank trucks or swimming pools from the *water* system through hydrants or other connections shall be metered. We will require residents to pay a \$40 refundable deposit to pick up a meter before the pool is filled and return the meter once finished so that we can get a more accurate water reading.
