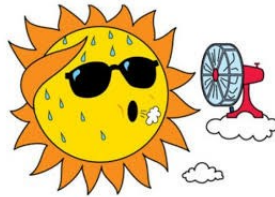


FRENDLIY REMINDER OF PARKING ORDINANCES SEC. 18-68

No person shall park a vehicle for more than 30 minutes between 2:30 am and 6:00 am on any street, highway or alley within the village except where permission to do so has been obtained from the police department. In emergency or to facilitate snow removal, any law enforcement officer and or village street employees may cause to be removed any vehicle parked on the street, highway or alley in violation of this restriction. The cost of such removal shall be charged to the owner of the vehicle and shall be in addition to any forfeiture imposed as a penalty.

Filling your Pool This Summer?



Please be advised that the Village of Minong will no longer allow residents to call in with their pool fill information.

We will be enforcing our ordinance under section 26-60 Bulk Water: All bulk water supplied to fill tank trucks or swimming pools from the water system through hydrants or other connections shall be metered. We will require residents to pay a \$40 refundable deposit to pick up a meter before the pool is filled and return the meter once finished so that we can get a more accurate water reading. **REMINDER—DOG LICENSES DUE BY APRIL
1ST, 2019**

Pursuant to WI Stat/ 174-052, notice is hereby given to all Washburn County dog owners that you are required to license and vaccinate for rabies under the provisions of WI State. 95.21 (2), any dog over 5 months of age. The license year is from Jan 1—Dec 31. Dogs not licensed within 30 days of ownership or after 5 months of age will be subject to a late fee of not less than \$5 per dog and will be subject to citation and forfeiture.

- Spayed Female-\$5.00
- Male-\$10.00
- Female-\$10.00
- Kennel-\$50.00

**SUMMER JETTING OF
SEWER LINES**



The Village of Minong is planning a summer jetting project in certain areas of the Village. The exact areas have not been determined, but you as a homeowner can still be prepared by keeping the toilet lids down in your home this summer because high pressure through the sewer lines can cause what is known as a “burp”. By keeping your lids down it will keep undesired sewer sludge from coming up out of the toilet. Be on the lookout for a big yellow truck this summer.

VILLAGE OF MINONG
WATER/SEWER BILLS**

The water and sewer quarterly bill for April, May and June will be sent out by July 10th, 2019. Please remember to keep your utility account up to date and pay your bill by the due date July 31st, 2019. All balances from the previous quarter, unless payment arrangements are made, should be paid in full prior to a new quarterly billing.

If you cannot pay your entire past due balance, payment arrangements can be made, but you must come in to the village office to sign a payment agreement, pay the most outstanding balance and make payment arrangements for any current charges due. If the payment agreement is not honored; your water service will be turned off and you will be charged a reconnect fee of \$25.
