It is very important that you make sure you are current to vote in the Village of Minong, and that you have the proper identification to vote. Those forms include: Wisconsin Driver's License; Wisconsin State ID; Wisconsin State or Driver ID receipt if you have just renewed your state or driver license; U.S. Passport Book or Card; University/College ID; U.S. Uniformed Service ID; Tribal ID; and Certification of Naturalization.

The Wisconsin Division of Motor Vehicles now provides a Photo ID free of charge for those who do not have a Photo ID. Please visit www.vote.org to register or confirm that you are registered to vote.



NEW! Village of Minong Transfer Station Cards

As of November 1st, all Village residents, Landlords and their tenants who currently use the Minong Transfer Station will need to come to the Minong Village Office to receive their new User Permit Card to be able to continue using the transfer station for waste disposal. The Village of Minong requires all Village Residents, Landlords and their tenants to sign a Transfer Station Dump Card Agreement to receive their new cards and show proof of residency for those using the cards. That could be a utility bill, or driver's license showing the name and address of the resident. There is only one card per household and they are not transferrable to another municipality, household or individual. A \$5.00 replacement fee will be charged for lost or damaged cards.

All Village residents currently using a waste pick up service and do not dump their garbage on their own, are not required to have this new card. Please feel free to contact the Minong Village Office at: 715-466-2322 should you have further questions.

SIDEWALK MAINTENANCE

This is a friendly reminder to property owners of their responsibility to keep their sidewalks free of snow and ice per Village Ordinance Sec 30-57, pertaining to the maintenance of sidewalks. Any owner, occupant or person in charge of any parcel or lot which fronts upon or adjoins any sidewalk shall keep the sidewalk bare of snow and ice. The resident is not permitted to shovel the excess snow into the street.

Removal shall take place within 24 hours from the time the snow ceases to accumulate on the sidewalk. If ice has formed in such a manner, that it cannot be removed, salt or sand should be sprinkled to permit safe travel by pedestrians. The village does have the authority to issue tickets and have the sidewalks cleaned at the owners expense after 24 hours without further notice to the resident, and the resident will be charged for the snow removal.



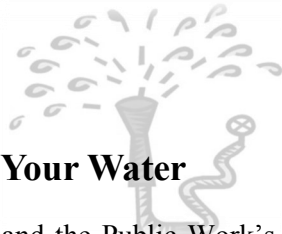
Running Your Water

Winter is approaching fast and the Public Work's department and the Village Office are aware of the concerns for some residents who need to run their water to prevent their pipes from freezing.

Our Public Work's department monitors the weather regularly. If you are required to run your water, you will be notified by the Village Office. Your utility account will be credited once you have been notified again by our office that running your water, is no longer necessary.

If you, as the Village resident, choose to run your water on your own, you will be responsible for the excess water usage and no credit will be applied.

DOG LICENSES DUE BY APRIL 1ST, 2020

Pursuant to WI Stat/ 174-052, notice is hereby given to all Washburn County dog owners that you are required to license and vaccinate for rabies under the provisions of WI State. 95.21(2), any dog over 5 months of age. The license year is from Jan 1—Dec 31. Dogs not licensed within 30 days of ownership or after 5 months of age will be subject to a late fee of not less than \$5 per dog and will be subject to citation and forfeiture.

- Male-\$10.00
