Farmers to Families Food Box

USDA is partnering with farmers, ranchers, specialty crop producers, food processors and distributors, and non-profit organizations to ensure that all Americans have access to the fresh and wholesome food they need during the COVID-19 national emergency.



When: 11/18/2020, 12/2/2020, 12/16/2020 and 12/30/2020 at 11:00AM until 2:00PM or until food (931 boxes each day) is gone.

Where: Washburn County Hwy Department, 1600 County Highway H, Spooner, WI 54801

Who is eligible: Anyone and Everyone! There is no income or local zip code required! Just pop your trunk!

Why? COVID-19 has been hard on everyone, so, instead of farmers throwing their crops and other products away The United States Department of Agriculture has partnered with farmers to bring their high quality products to communities in need of assistance. On November 18 and December 2, 16, and 30th, you will be able to pick up a FREE box that contains 5-6 pounds of fresh produce, some dairy products like cheese and yogurt, some different types of proteins and a gallon of milk!
