



## VILLAGE OF MINONG – TYPE E NOTICE

### VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT

Partisan Primary Election – Tuesday, August 11, 2026

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may request to vote an absentee ballot. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen who will be 18 years of age or older on Election Day, who has resided in the Village of Minong for at least 10 consecutive days before the election, and who is registered to vote. Proof of identification is required before an absentee ballot may be issued.

#### Requesting an Absentee Ballot

- You must make a request for an absentee ballot in writing. Contact your municipal clerk and request that an application for an absentee ballot be sent to you for the primary, the election, or both. You may also submit a written request in the form of a letter. Your written request must include: Your voting address within the Village, the address where the ballot should be sent (if different), and your signature. You may apply by mail, email, or in person.

#### Deadline for Requesting an Absentee Ballot by Mail

5:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 6, 2026. (Fifth day before the election – Wis. Stat. § 6.86(1)(b))

Note: Special provisions apply to voters who are indefinitely confined, hospitalized, in the military, or serving as sequestered jurors. Contact the municipal clerk for applicable deadlines.

#### In-Person Absentee Voting

- You may also vote an absentee ballot in person in the clerk's office during the days and hours specified below.

##### In-Person Voting Dates:

- Begins: Tuesday, July 28, 2026 | 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.
- Ends: Friday, August 7, 2026 | 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

No in-person absentee voting may occur on the day before the election (Monday, August 10, 2026).

#### Returning Absentee Ballots

The municipal clerk will deliver all voted absentee ballots received on or before Election Day to the proper polling place before the polls close on August 11, 2026. Any ballots received after the polls close will not be counted.
